Pastor Elizabeth Boyd was not aware in 1996 when she took a young woman into her home, who had been tragically wounded by life, that God would use this experience to birth her into purpose. While managing a demanding full-time job at Bellsouth, a husband, and four children of her own, one of which was terminally ill, by day Pastor Boyd would go through her daily routine. By night, however, she

would battle the very kingdom of darkness on behalf of this young lady's soul. A labor of love that she endured for three years so that God may get glory out of both of their lives.

Pastor Boyd has known since she was a child that she was called to minister to the hurting and destitute. She has been called by God specifically to the area of deliverance and has been operating in that gift for over 8 years. She was ordained on October 25, 1998 and is currently the Director of the Ministerial Alliance at Bethel Full Gospel Baptist Church where she serves under the careful tutelage of Senior Pastor /Teacher, Bishop Carlos L. Malone, Sr.

With an open and steadfast heart, Pastor Boyd ministers to the needs of hurting women. She also ministers to inmates in South Florida's prison system where she has been fortunate to witness the life changing power of God through salvation.

Her educational background includes a Bachelors degree in interpersonal and group communications from Trinity International University where she graduated with high honors. At present she is actively pursuing a Masters degree in Christian Counseling. In the near future Pastor Boyd plans to publish her first book entitled "Caring for the needs of a terminally ill child: Love has everything to do with it!" This intense, in-depth look at the relationship between a mother and her terminally ill child is based on Pastor Boyd's personal story. Like Rizpah, she fought sickness, disease, and decay so that her daughter could live the full life that doctors said she would never have.

Pastor Boyd resides in Miami, FL with her husband Minister Eddie B. Boyd. Together they have four children to their union: Thelma Carey, who went home to be with the Lord on December 1, 2003, Tammy, Jonathan, and Hannah.
